Schwerpunkte der Präsentation:

- Analysis of Domino Server Cluster Environment - defined according to Lotus Specifications
- Tackling the problem of maintaining and centralizing aging Mail and Fax data.
- Integrating TOPCALL with LEGATO's EmailXtender.
- Optical Character Recognition and Indexing to make FAX Document Archives searchable.
- Offloading old messages from the Domino Servers while maintaining transparent user access.
- Minimizing potential damage by being able to find messages across the entire archive.
- Assuring that no messages are lost and eliminating the need for time-consuming restores for a single email.
- Archiving all incoming and outgoing emails for SEC 17a-4 and NASD compliance.
- Extracting existing messages and moving older ones to reduce disk load on the Mail Servers.
